Thousands of households in Illinois do not have local telephone service. You can help make a difference for struggling households in your community.

For too many in Illinois, the cost of a telephone to connect them to family, emergency services, and employers is just too high. Persons with disabilities, senior citizens, and families with young children are among the most vulnerable without a telephone. You can help connect them to emergency help, caretakers, schools, and employers by contributing to the Universal Telephone Assistance Corporation (UTAC).

The UTAC Lifeline and Link-Up programs

are funded entirely through voluntary donations. These programs work with the federally-funded Lifeline program to help Illinois households obtain local phone service and receive a partial discount on their monthly phone bills.

It is easy to contribute. Simply fill out the form below and indicate the amount you would like to give per month – 50 cents, \$1, \$2, or as much as \$5. That amount can be paid with your monthly telephone bill. Your contribution will be supplemented by federal funds to help provide phone service for individuals and families who could not otherwise afford it.

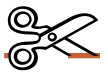

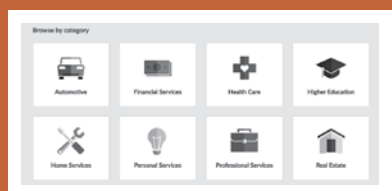
Egyptian director re-elected president of state association

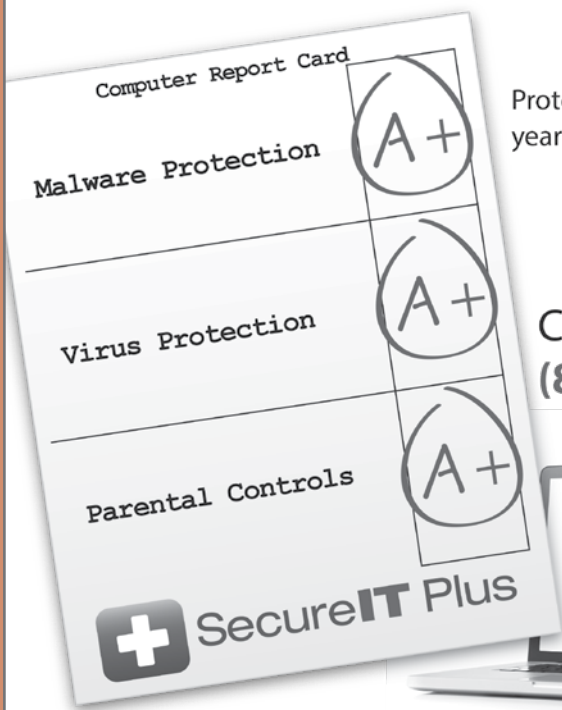
Illinois Digital Divide Elimination Fund
